## Evening League

Evening League is open to all teams and curlers!

<b>One Night</b>	<b>\$599</b>
<b>Two Nights</b>	<b>\$718</b>
<b>Three Nights</b>	<b>\$798</b>

Evening League runs Monday through Thursday from October to April. Opportunity to play up to 28 weeks.

<b>Senior Rate - 1 Night</b>	<b>\$508</b>
<b>Senior Rate - 2 Nights</b>	<b>\$613</b>
<b>Senior Rate - 3 Nights</b>	<b>\$676</b>

Senior Rate applies only to persons 65 years and over.

**New Curler** **\$371.50**

New Curler Rate applies only to beginners, not experienced curlers from another club.

**House Membership** **\$220**

House Membership benefits include voting privileges at the AGM, an opportunity to curl in playdowns, and adding your name to the spare list.

**Spare Fees** **\$10/game**

For non-members only. After 3 games spared, either a house or league membership must be purchased.
